Greetings! My name is Ms. Schueller, and I am the 5th grade teacher at St. Paul School. I am starting my eighth year here. This is my third year teaching 5th grade. Things are up and running in the 5th grade classroom this year. In theology we started the year learning about God's creation and why He created the Earth for us. Currently in science we are studying the characteristics of living things and how they are classified. We began our Social Studies lesson 40,000 years ago when the early people were crossing the Bering Strait from Asia into the Americas. Right now reading consists of learning about the different genres, and story structure, such as plot and setting. Language Arts has started out with sentence types, writing sentences properly, finding complete subjects and predicates, and finding simple subjects and predicates.

We have welcomed a new student to the 5th grade as well as some new technology. The 5th grade classroom now has a Smartboard. The students and I are really enjoying the Smartboard. It has really enhanced our lessons. The students enjoy being able to come up to the Smartboard and use it during our lessons. So far the school year is off to a great start and I am looking forward to a successful school year.
