The 3rd and 4th grade classes have been very busy!

In Language Arts we are working on parts of speech, subject and predicate, paragraph structure, finding evidence in text, and keeping up with our reading. March was amazing with Reading Month, and some of them took a well needed break from reading, but we're back into the swing of reading daily! We are also working on cursive and it's getting easier every day!

In Math, we are learning adding, subtracting, and multiplying fractions while we are still working on our fact fluency. We are finding that without quick recall of simple facts, we struggle with tasks like fractions.

In Social Studies, we are working on summing up all 5 Regions we have learned about in the US. We will be having a final test on all 50 states and their abbreviations soon!

In Science, we are working through our Physical Science unit and will finish matter today! We have made soda pop, rock candy (that didn't work ;-)), Oobleck, and witnessed various experiments that explain how matter changes.

In Religion, we are working on memorizing Hail Holy Queen and studying vocations and how through ministry we can serve God.

We are looking forward to going to Paradise Park in Novi for our end of the school year field trip! In order to offset the cost of our trip, students are collecting returnable bottles/cans! This has been another goal setting experience for us to try to fill the garbage can every few days! We will be attending the Lansing Symphony with other schools in the area, taking their recorders with them to experience playing along with the musicians! In Art, we are studying Georgia O'Keefe and her artistic style. In Gym, we are training for Field Day and working on assessments. In Computers, we are making virtue videos. We just finished NWEA and ROCKED it! We are also thankful for it to be done until next year!
