Speaking of which, the kindergarten students are doing exceptionally well attending Mass each week! Not to mention their first experience with Adoration and Benediction! They have learned how to genuflect, how to make the sign of the cross, follow along with the prayers, participate during Holy Communion and even how to control their wiggles and giggles! Our current focus is learning all about God’s provision of family and friends and how we can love and care for them.

In kindergarten, students have to be engaged in active, hands on and “play” based learning that appeals to and inspires young learners. Religion, math, reading, writing, science, and social studies, (although addressed individually with specific lessons and assigned certain time slots throughout our day), seem to intertwine. As a result, the students are developing a love for learning and are making great strides in all subject areas! For example, this week, we opened up a pretend pumpkin patch in our classroom! Throughout this activity, the students have been measuring, adding, subtracting, writing, reading, creating and discovering! As an added bonus, we also attended our first field trip to Peacock Farms! It was a wonderful first field trip filled with learning, discovery, and real world application that the students, their families and teachers enjoyed!

We have a lot of learning ahead to master, but I have no doubt that each one of these students will succeed. One of the wonderful advantages of having a small class is being able to devote time to them individually. When told that I only had five students in my class at the beginning of the year, my response to Mrs. Heatwole was, “Well, I’ll have no excuse but to turn out five “Einsteins”!” It is my privilege, goal and blessing to have the opportunity to do so!
